Buying wavelengths from two providers was never proof of physical separation. Even truly diverse Day-1 paths drift back into shared risk as networks are groomed, rerouted, and expanded. You rarely discover the overlap during procurement. You discover it during an outage.

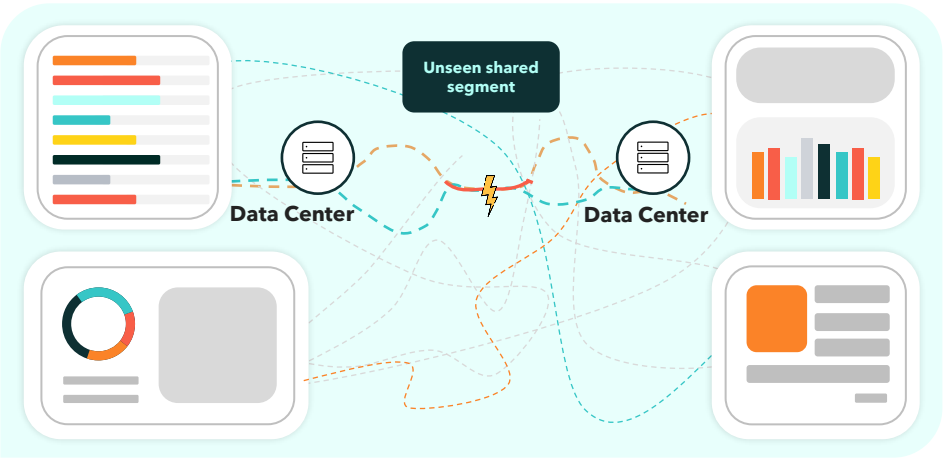
But there’s a second problem hiding behind the first: In a multi-vendor environment, checking whether you still have diversity is hard. Every provider brings its own portal, its own data, and its own support model so the proof you need can be scattered across tools that don’t talk to each other. The more vendors you add in the name of diversity, the harder verification may become.

More vendors. More tools. Less visibility.

The multi-vendor model can multiply operational overhead. Each provider you add to seek diversity adds another portal to log into, another data set to reconcile, and another support queue to chase during an incident. Tool fragmentation grows, coordination fatigue sets in, and the single most important question “are my routes still diverse” gets harder to answer, not easier.

Where complexity can creep in:

- Tool fragmentation – a separate portal per vendor, with no unified view.
- Visibility gaps – no single tool sees the full physical path end to end.
- Coordination fatigue – every change means reconciling multiple parties.
- Vendor sprawl – more contracts and SLAs mean more seams where overlap hides.
- Shared restoration paths stay invisible, because no one tool sees across vendors.



And these problems can compound.

As infrastructure velocity climbs AI density, east-west traffic growth, constant grooming of the gaps do not allow them to remain steady. They can widen. The market is already feeling it:

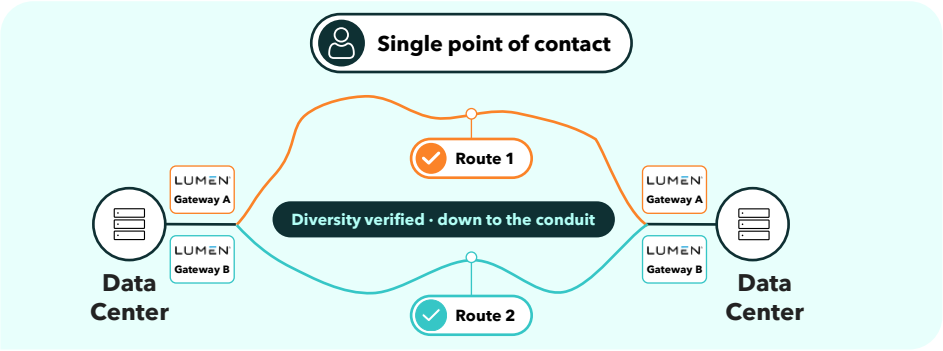

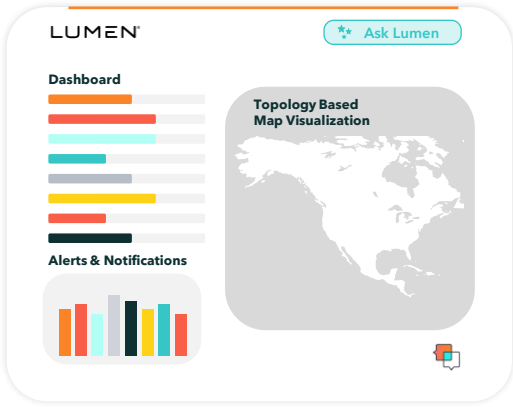
