Every May, Churchill Downs hosts approximately 385,000 visitors for the Kentucky Derby®, causing digital demands to spike from 2-3Gb to nearly 200Gb daily. To manage this, they needed to upgrade their digital infrastructure for smooth connectivity for live broadcasts, social media, betting platforms, and point-of-sale systems.
