Poly Edge E400/E450 Quick Reference Guide



1. Handset

Microban® antimicrobial protection helps your handset resist the growth of microbes such as bacteria and mold.

2. Line keys

E400 & E450: 8 plus 6 on secondary display

3. Back button

Return to previous screen

4. LED bar: Visual indicator of call & phone status

Green - blinking: incoming call

Green - solid: active call

Red - blinking: all calls on hold and/or new voicemail

Yellow - blinking: idle mode

Blue - chase animation: Bluetooth discovery mode on E450; E400 does not support Bluetooth.

- 5. Color display
- 6. Pagination key

Used to view additional line screens

7. Softkeys

Context-sensitive keys that change depending on your phone's status

- 8. Home
- 9. Navigation and select buttons
- 10. Secondary screen and line keys
- 11. Secondary screen pagination key
- 12. Mute
- 13. Speakerphone
- 14. Headset
- 15. Volume

Adjusts volume for handset, headset, speaker and ringer

- 16. Transfer
- 17. Hold
- 18. Voicemail



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Place a call

Do one of the following:

- Pick up the handset, enter the number, and press the **send** softkey.
- Press the **speakerphone** (a) or **headset** (b) key, enter the number, and press the **send** softkey.
- Enter the number, press the **dial** softkey then pick up the handset.
- Enter the number and press the **speakerphone** (a) or **headset** (a) key.
- Press the **line key**, enter the number, and press the **send** softkey.
- Press **new call** softkey, enter the number, and press the **send** softkey.

Answer a call

Do one of the following:

- Press the **answer** softkey.
- Press the headset key.
- Press the **speakerphone** (a) key.
- Pick up the handset.

Hold and resume a call

- Hold: Highlight the call and press the hold \ key or hold softkey.
- **Resume**: Highlight the call press the **hold ** key or **resume** softkey.

End a call

Press the end softkey.

Transferring calls

Attended transfer

- 1. Press and hold the **transfer (+C)** key or **transfer** softkey.
- 2. Choose consultative.
- 3. Dial a number or chose a contact.
- 4. After announcing the caller to your contact, press the **transfer** (*) key or **transfer** softkey to complete the transfer.

Blind transfer

- . Press and hold the **transfer** or **transfer** softkey...
- 2. Choose blind.
- Enter a number or choose a contact. The call is transferred immediately.

Conference calls

- 1. On an active call, select the **conference** softkey. The person you are talking to is placed on hold and you receive a dial tone.
- 2. Enter a number, select a contact from the directory, or select a contact from a call list.
- 3. When the contact answers, select the **conference** softkey to connect all parties.
 - If the contact is not available to join the call, press the **cancel** softkey to release the contact and return to your original call.

Forwarding calls

Forward an incoming

- 1. Without answering the call, press the **forward** softkey.
- 2. Enter the number to forward the call.
- 3. Press the **forward** softkey again.

Forward all calls

- 1. Press the **forward** softkey or go to settings > features > forward.
- 2. On the **forwarding type select** screen, select a forwarding type:
 - ALWAYS. Incoming calls are forwarded unconditionally.
 - BUSY. Incoming calls are forwarded when phone is busy.
 - NO ANSWER. Incoming calls are forwarded if not answered after a time. (This is the only option for shared lines)
- 3. Enter a number and press enable.
 - If you selected **no answer**, enter the number of rings before the call is forwarded.

Preferences

Ringtone

- 1. Go to menu > settings > basic.
- 2. Press ring type.
- 3. Press the **play** softkey to hear the ringtone (optional) and make your selection.
- 4. Press the **select** softkey to apply the ringtone.

Volume

- 1. Mute: Press the **mute** softkey or key 🕙.
- 2. Volume: Press the **volume** key up or down to adjust the volume of the ringer, media, and audio on an active call.

Voicemail

When you have a new voicemail, a message icon is displayed on the home screen, in the status bar, and next to the phone line on the lines screen.

- 1. Go to messages > message center > connect.
- 2. Follow the prompts to access your messages.

Favorites

Favorites are the contacts in your directory that you call most often. Favorites display as speed dials on the Lines screen. When you add a contact to the directory, the phone adds them as a favorite by default.

Add a favorite

- 1. Do one of the following:
 - Go to directories > contact directory.
 - Long press a key for an available line (+).
- 2. Select a contact, then select **edit**.
- 3. Select **favorite index**, then add a new number.

Move favorite to a different screen

Display a favorite contact on the primary or secondary screen.

- 1. Do one of the following:
 - On the lines screen, long press the line key (+) for the contact.
 - Go to **directories** and select a contact.
- 2. Select edit > location and chose primary or secondary.

Wi-Fi (E450 only)

Enable Wi-Fi

- . Go to menu > Wi-Fi or menu > settings > basic > Wi-Fi menu.
- 2. Press the **select** key to enable Wi-Fi, then press **save**.
- Press **reboot**. After the phone reboots, it can connect to a wireless network.

Connect to a wireless network

- 1. Do one of the following:
 - Press the **scan** softkey to scan for available networks, select one and enter the network's required security settings.
 - Press the **other** softkey to manually enter network settings, including SSID, security type and password.
- Select connect.
